Sagol School of Neuroscience and Adams Super Center for Brain Studies are offering scholarships to neurosciences graduate and postdoctoral students and lab managers who wish to actively participate in conferences during the academic year of 2021-2022 (תשפ"ב), students who have been invited to an overseas laboratory in collaboration with the student's laboratory, and students who are travelling abroad for the purpose of participating in courses and workshops offered in academic institutions overseas. All these activities should be linked to main neuroscience research activity of the labs. These scholarships are granted as travel expense returns (flight, accommodation, registration) for up to 2000 NIS (in lieu of receipts).



Please note a few important changes:

- Adams grant will be granted <u>2 times</u> in an academic year (June 2022, November 2022) students must hand in their reimbursement documents during the academic year in which the grant was approved, unless they received a specific approval from the Sagol school administrative staff.
- 2. We have a new form for the advisor/PI to sign instead of the letter of recommendation. Applications without this approval will not be accepted (see appendix 3).



Eligibility:

- Students of advanced degrees or research fellows whose research is in
 neurosciences and whose work is to be presented in an academic conference during
 the academic year of 2021-2022 and/or for the purpose of collaboration with an
 overseas laboratory and/or traveler participating in courses and workshops offered
 in overseas academic institutions.
- 2. Students whose laboratory is registered with the Sagol School of Neuroscience.
- 3. Application submitted by the student.
- 4. Participation (by invitation) in university ceremonies to present the student's research.
- 5. Winning students may reapply to additional calls for grant funding opportunities in a single year (two opportunities in total throughout the year), knowing that preference will be given to new applicants.

Please note: Due to the COVID-19 worldwide outbreak we will accept applications for conferences held virtually and cover application fees for students presenting in the conference (poster or oral presentation).
